Development Programme of Cancer Institutions in India

Department of Atomic Energy (DAE) has been supporting a comprehensive programme on research and treatment of cancer in India. In order to provide better health facilities to common man, cancer institutions in India are provided financial assistance for buying equipment and/or carrying research projects. The Department consider specific requests for Grant-in-aid on the basis of certain objectives which include:

- i) Development and deployment of indigenously developed medical technology.
- ii) Projects that contribute to greater understanding of problem of Cancer in India.
- iii) Clinical Research/Trials related to Cancer
- iv) Support to Cancer Hospitals with deficient resources that serve poor and people in remote areas.

Applications are invited from Cancer Institutions and Research Centres for financial assistance for equipment and research projects under this programme. Detailed project proposals should be submitted to DAE in the following format-

Part A : Details of the project/equipment

- a) Details regarding equipment/accessories/research projects
- b) Provision for space in the hospital /laboratory for housing the equipment with details.
- c) Technical specifications and budgetary quotations in support of funds required
- d) Existing facilities, manpower and activities.

Part B : Support information with respect to the organization

- a) Societal objectives of the organization and subsidy provided to the needy patients
- b) Optimal utilization and research objectives
- c) Credibility and long term viability of the organization
- d) Application of indigenous equipment/novel ideas/radiological protocol and procedures
- e) Time frame of implementation of the project

Part C :

- a) Name and address of Supplier
- b) Local or imported
- c) Cost (Rs/US\$)
- d) Any similar equipment(s) available in Dept. (Type & Date)
- e) Details of previous grants/date received from DAE and utilization certificate thereof duly certified by a Chartered Accountant.
- f) A copy of the Annual Report including Statement of Accounts.

Each of these points at Part A & B above shall be considered for evaluating the Application. Information missing against any point shall be taken as 'nil'. A separate sheet may be attached for describing each parameter if required.
